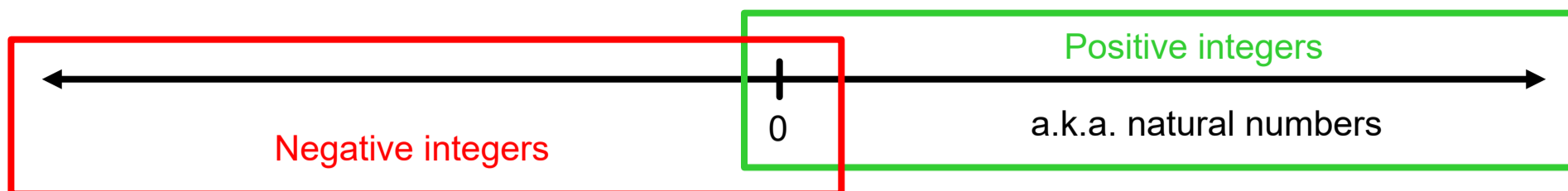


# Panorama 3.1 - More or Less



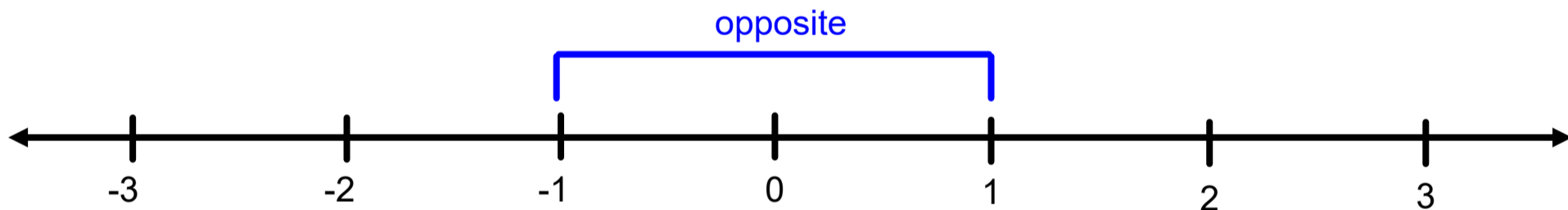
Positive integers correspond to natural numbers (0, 1, 2, ...) preceded with a "+" sign.

Negative integers correspond to natural numbers preceded with a "-" sign.

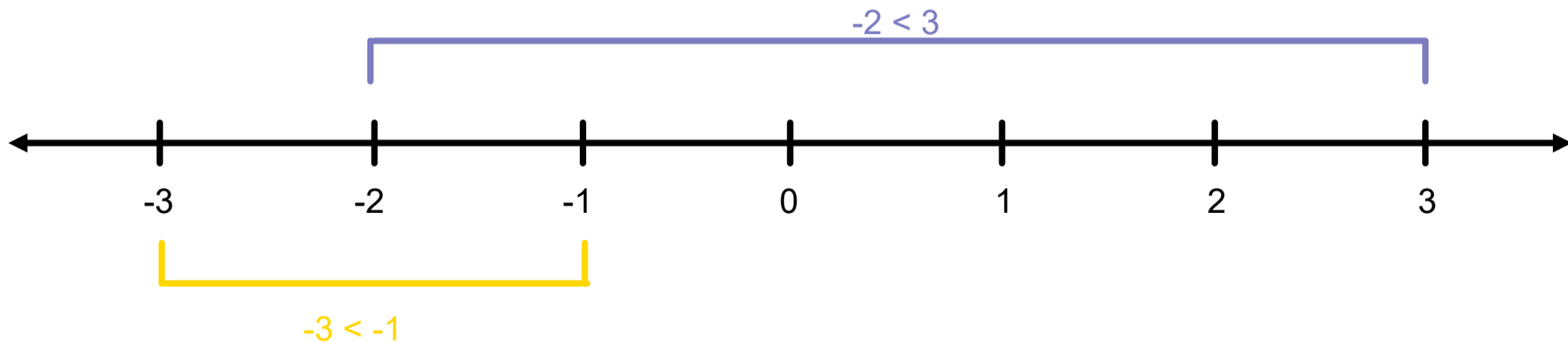
The set of integers is composed of positive and negative integers.

Examples	Non-examples
1, 3, 5, 7, 8	1.2, 57.100, 21.21
100, 12, -2, -57	5/3, 18.15, -8.1
-21, -10	2/4, 57%

Negative integers are the opposite of positive integers. On a number line, negative and positive integers are placed on either side of zero. Every integer has an opposite located at the same distance from zero.



The number line is a useful tool for comparing two, or more, integers. The integer located farthest to the left is less than the other.
